Serious Incident Investigation Interim Statement

Geronimo² M-27 Paraglider Sai Kung, Hong Kong 28 April 2020

In accordance with the Hong Kong Civil Aviation (Investigation of Accidents) Regulations (Cap. 448B), an investigation is in progress to determine the circumstances and causes relating to the serious incident involving a Geronimo² M-27 paraglider after it took off from Ma On Shan in Sai Kung, Hong Kong on 28 April 2020.

The Air Accident Investigation Authority is analysing the causes of the serious incident based on all collected evidence.

In accordance with paragraph 6.6 of Annex 13 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, if the report cannot be made publicly available within twelve months, the State/Administration conducting the investigation shall make an interim statement publicly available on each anniversary of the occurrence, detailing the progress of the investigation and any safety issues raised.
