Serious Incident Investigation Interim Statement

Bombardier Global 5000, P4-AVA and Boeing 737-81B, B-1918
Hong Kong International Airport
13 November 2018

In accordance with the Hong Kong Civil Aviation (Investigation of Accidents) Regulations (Cap. 448B), an investigation is in progress to determine the circumstances and causes relating to the serious incident involving an MS Aviation GmbH Bombardier Global 5000 aircraft, registration P4-AVA, and a China Southern Airlines Boeing 737-81B aircraft, registration B-1918, when they were landing at Hong Kong International Airport on 13 November 2018.

Based on all collected evidence, the investigation team is analysing the causes of the serious incident and preparing the final report on the investigation.

In accordance with paragraph 6.6 of Annex 13 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, if the report cannot be made publicly available within twelve months, the State/Administration conducting the investigation shall make an interim statement publicly available on each anniversary of the occurrence, detailing the progress of the investigation and any safety issues raised.
