

Improvement works to Tsing Lun Road and Tsz Tin Road gazetted

The Government published a notice in the Gazette today (November 21) on a scheme to improve Tsing Lun Road and Tsz Tin Road. The scheme, aiming to serve the anticipated traffic demand induced by housing development in the area, had been authorised by the Chief Executive in Council.

Proposed works include widening of a section of Tsing Lun Road and Tsz Tin Road; modification of Tsing Lun Road's junction with Hong Po Road and Tsz Tin Road's junction with Tsing Lun Road; reprovision of footpaths and bus lay-bys, construction of cycle tracks, a covered footbridge, run-ins/outs, a cycle park, noise barriers and noise enclosures; and ancillary works including waterworks, drainage and landscaping works.

The works will start in 2010 for completion by 2013.
