

Proposed access road from Deep Bay Road to Tin Yuet Road, Yuen Long gazetted

The Government published a Gazette notice today (May 6) on the proposed access road from Deep Bay Road to Tin Yuet Road, Yuen Long.

The proposed works are as follows:

- (i) upgrading of a section of the existing access road approximately 600 metres long to a two-lane two-way carriageway with associated footpaths;
- (ii) construction of sections of carriageways and footpaths;
- (iii) construction of a maintenance access and a village access;
- (iv) temporary/permanent closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and maintenance access; and
- (vi) ancillary works including waterworks, civil, drainage, slope, landscaping and utilities works.
