

Proposed retrofitting of lifts at footbridge near Fung Shing Court, Sha Tin gazetted

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The Government published a Gazette notice today (August 26) on the proposed retrofitting of lifts at the footbridge across Lion Rock Tunnel Road near Fung Shing Court, Sha Tin, aiming to provide barrier-free access facilities.

Proposed works include:

- (i) construction of two lifts, one at the northern side of the footbridge and one at the southern side of the footbridge;
- (ii) construction of elevated platforms connecting the two lifts in (i) to the existing footbridge;
- (iii) conversion of sections of the existing planting area and part of the slope into footpaths; and
- (iv) ancillary works including drainage, lighting and electrical and mechanical works.

The work is expected to commence in mid 2012 and will take about 24 months to complete.
