

Proposed vehicular bridge at Kiu Hing Road near Wong Nai Tun gazetted

The Government published a notice in the Gazette today (November 4) on the proposed construction of a vehicular bridge crossing a nullah, linking Kiu Hing Road and a road near Wong Nai Tun.

The proposed works include:

- (a) construction of a vehicular bridge across the nullah at Kiu Hing Road near Wong Nai Tun with associated footpaths;
- (b) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways; and
- (c) ancillary works including drainage and road works; and provision of lighting.

The works are expected to commence in the fourth quarter of 2012 and be completed in the first quarter of 2014.
