

## **Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)**

### **Scheme annexed to Plan No. CE39/GZ/001 under section 5 describing**

### **Road Works under PWP Item No. 4444DS Construction of Dry Weather Flow Interceptor at Wan Chai East**

#### General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Logistics under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. CE39/GZ/001 (“the Plan”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed works are required to facilitate the construction of a dry weather flow interceptor at Wan Chai East, which will help to reduce the discharge of pollutants into Victoria Harbour through the Wan Chai East box culvert in order to improve the coastal water quality and the overall environment at Wan Chai East.

2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows: –
  - (i) permanent closure of a section of the carriageway which is under PWP Item No. 7677CL Wan Chai Development Phase II – Proposed Road Works (“7677CL Project”);
  - (ii) temporary closure and reconstruction of a section of the carriageway which is under 7677CL Project; and
  - (iii) ancillary works including utilities, paving and finishes, coach parking reinstatement, tree protection, building services and landscaping works.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently a section of the carriageway; and to close temporarily a section of the carriageway within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageway is to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, watermains, stormwater drains, sewers, gas pipes and any other apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
