

Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

Road Improvement Works at Wo Hop Shek Cemetery for
Phases 2 and 3 Columbarium Development**

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Logistics under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. CE58/GZ/RW/100 to CE58/GZ/RW/106 (“the Plans”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to provide the necessary road improvement works at Wo Hop Shek Cemetery for phases 2 and 3 columbarium development.

2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:–

- (i) construction of carriageways, footpaths, a lay-by and pedestrian crossings;
- (ii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, central reserves/refuge islands, lay-bys, amenity areas and slopes;
- (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways, a central reserve/refuge island, lay-bys, amenity areas and slopes;
- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing amenity areas into a carriageway and a footpath;
- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing central reserves/refuge islands into carriageways and a footpath;

- (vi) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, amenity areas and central reserves/refuge islands;
- (vii) demolition and conversion of sections of the existing slopes into carriageways, footpaths, lay-bys, amenity areas and central reserves/refuge islands; and
- (viii) ancillary works including slope stabilization, geotechnical, drainage, sewerage, water supplies, utilities, lighting, landscaping, electrical and mechanical works, installation of street furniture, traffic aids, traffic control and surveillance system, as well as construction of retaining walls and slopes.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, amenity areas and central reserves/refuge islands; and to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, amenity areas, pedestrian crossings and central reserves/refuge islands within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths, amenity areas, pedestrian crossings and central reserves/refuge islands are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, drainage pipes, sewers, gas pipes and any other apparatus lying within the limit of works area and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
