

Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

Scheme annexed to Plan No. CDEKAT0014 under section 5 describing

Hung Hom Urban Park

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Logistics under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. CDEKAT0014 (“the Plan”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed Hung Hom Urban Park serves to provide an open space for public enjoyment of the waterfront.

2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows –
 - (i) construction of dropped kerbs;
 - (ii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into open space and footpaths;
 - (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageway and open space;
 - (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing amenity areas into open space;
 - (v) temporary closure and repaving of sections of the existing footpaths;
 - (vi) permanent demolition of the existing canopy; and
 - (vii) ancillary works including drainage, water supplies, utilities, public lighting, landscaping, and electrical and mechanical works.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas; and temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, stormwater drains, sewerage pipes, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
