## TUEN MUN SOUTH EXTENSION

## AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND ALTERATION OF SECTIONS OF WU YUET STREET

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Logistics, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:-

- (I) the temporary closure and alteration of the section of Wu Yuet Street between its junction with Wu King Road and a point about 15 metres northwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered TMSE/G06/0010/2, with details as follows:
  - (a) from 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on 21 to 30 days during the period from 19 July 2025 to 18 July 2026, with all carriageway widths temporarily closed; and
  - (b) during the period from 19 July 2025 to 18 July 2026, except the period specified in (I)(a) above, with the carriageway widths temporarily altered;
- (II) the temporary closure of the section of Wu Yuet Street between a point about 15 metres northwest of its junction with Wu King Road and a point about 135 metres northwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered TMSE/G06/0010/2, with details as follows:
  - (a) from 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on 21 to 30 days during the period from 19 July 2025 to 18 July 2026, with all carriageway widths temporarily closed; and
  - (b) during the period from 19 July 2025 to 18 July 2026, except the period specified in (II)(a) above, with parts of the carriageway widths temporarily closed.

I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that during the period from 19 July 2025 to 18 July 2026, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of road as described above shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
