

## **Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)**

### **Scheme annexed to Plan No. YLM11315 under section 5 describing**

#### **Proposed Road Improvement Works at Sha Po, Yuen Long**

##### General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Logistics under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. YLM11315 (“the Plan”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works at Sha Po of Yuen Long are required to serve the proposed comprehensive development project and improve the traffic facilities in the area.

2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, central medians/refuge islands, a run-in/run-out, pedestrian crossings and amenity areas;
- (ii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, central medians/refuge islands, pedestrian crossings and amenity areas;
- (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways, cycle tracks, a central median/refuge island, pedestrian crossings and an amenity area;
- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing cycle tracks into carriageways, footpaths, a verge, a central median/refuge island and pedestrian crossings;

- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing verges into carriageways, a footpath, a central median/refuge island and a pedestrian crossing;
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing central medians/refuge islands into carriageways;
- (vii) permanent closure and demolition of a section of the existing carriageway;
- (viii) permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing footpaths;
- (ix) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks and central medians/refuge islands;
- (x) temporary closure and reconstruction of a section of the existing verge;
- (xi) demolition and conversion of sections of the existing slopes into carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, a central median/refuge island and a pedestrian crossing; and
- (xii) ancillary works including slope stabilization, landscaping, drainage, sewerage, water, street lighting, road marking and utilities works, as well as construction of retaining walls.

### Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, verges and central medians/refuge islands; and to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, verges and central medians/refuge islands within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan. Temporary alternative access will be provided and

temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, verges and central medians/refuge islands are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, drainage pipes, gas pipes and any other apparatus lying within the limit of works area and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
